- Keep a copy of the signed forms for your records.

In order to complete your application and to participate in the event, you and your parent/guardian need to review and return the "Signature Page" and the Delaware and Microsoft Partnership Event Participation and Confidentiality Agreement of the DigiGirlz forms. Your application for the DigiGirlz Event will not be fully completed until we have received the "Signature Page" form and the Delaware and Microsoft Partnership Event Participation and Confidentiality Agreement from you.
